June 1, 2025 — Seventh Sunday of Easter

Jesus Is with Us in His Holy Christian Church

On the night when He was betrayed, Jesus interceded for His Church — for His apostles and all who believe in Him through their word — that all of His disciples “*may become perfectly one*” in the Father and the Son (John 17:21–23). For Jesus became flesh and dwells among us in order to reveal the Father and His name, to share with us the glory of His righteousness, and to bring us to the Father in Himself. As the Father loved the Son from “*before the foundation of the world*” (John 17:24), so He loves the whole world (John 17:23, 26). Through the apostolic witness to the Baptism, cross and resurrection of Jesus (Acts 1:21–22), the Lord gathers His disciples throughout the world “*with one accord*” as one body in Christ (Acts 1:14). And so with one voice and by one Spirit, His Bride prays, “*Come*” (Rev. 22:17). And He comes to us. He gives us “*the water of life without price*” to wash our robes and quench our thirst (Rev. 22:17); He feeds us from “*the tree of life with its twelve kinds of fruit*” (Rev. 22:2).

The Holy Spirit Gives Peace

Following the flood, Noah's descendants failed to spread out and fill the earth as God had spoken. Rather, they exalted themselves; with *"one language and the same words"* (Gen. 11:1), they spoke proudly and arrogantly. The Lord humbled them by confusing *"the language of all the earth,"* dividing and dispersing the people (Gen. 11:9). That dispersal was reversed on Pentecost Day (the 50th day of Easter), when God caused the one Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ to be preached in a multitude of languages. *"At this sound the multitude came together"* (Acts 2:6), for the preaching of Christ is the primary work of the Holy Spirit, whereby He gathers people from all nations into one Church. The Holy Spirit teaches and brings to our remembrance the words of Jesus, which are the words of the Father who sent Him. These words bestow forgiveness and peace to those who keep and hold on to them in love for Jesus. *"Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid"* (John 14:27).

The Triune God Reveals Himself in Christ Jesus

The divine Word of the Father also is the holy wisdom who “*was beside him, like a master workman,*” who “*was daily his delight, rejoicing before him always*” (Prov. 8:30). This Word became flesh and suffered death in order to bestow life by the preaching of His Gospel “*to the children of man*” (Prov. 8:4). Jesus Brings Release from the Bonds of Sin, Death and the Devil

The Lord finds those who did not seek Him or ask for Him. He spreads out His hands *“to a rebellious people”* (Is. 65:2) and calls them to be His people and to dwell in peace upon His holy mountain (Is. 65:9). For wherever Jesus Christ enters in, Satan is cast out. Those who were enslaved and driven mad by the assaults and accusations of the devil are set free by the Word of Christ. He drowns and destroys the old Adam in us with the waters of Holy Baptism and thereby brings us out of death into life. No longer naked in our shame, living *“among the tombs”* (Luke 8:27), we are brought into the Lord's house, fully clothed by Christ; He has come in *“the fullness of time”* (Gal. 4:4) to fulfill the Law on our behalf and to redeem us from its every accusation. Therefore, having been justified by His grace through faith in His Gospel, *“you are no longer a slave, but a son”* (Gal. 4:7).

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June 29, 2025 — St. Peter and St. Paul, Apostles

St. Peter and St. Paul, Apostles

Jesus is “*the Christ, the Son of the living God.*” So confessed St. Peter. And Christ promised to build His Church on it by the forgiveness of sins (Matt. 16:16–19). He does this so we don’t try to build the Church ourselves, on this or that person, or by any human means. “*Let no one boast in men ... whether Paul or Apollos or Cephas,*” (1 Cor. 3:21–23). The same Lord “*who worked through Peter ... worked also through*” Paul and is still at work in His Gospel and Sacraments (Gal. 2:7–8). The Church of every age must be recalled to “*hear the word of the gospel*” — the free forgiveness of sins for Christ’s sake apart from the Law — “*and believe.*” The Holy Spirit makes “*no distinction*” among men, but cleanses “*hearts by faith*” alone. So “*we will be saved through the grace of the Lord Jesus*” (Acts 15:7–11). Both were imprisoned (Acts 12:1–11), both wrote Scripture (2 Peter 3:15–16), both opposed the world — and sometimes each other (Gal. 2:11–16) — all so “*that the truth of the gospel might be preserved*” for us (Gal. 2:5).
